Investment strategy

The Sub-Fund invests principally in below-investment-grade debt securities (oftencalled "high yield" securities or "junk bonds") of U.S. corporate issuers that are rated BB through B by Standard & Poor's or Ba through B byMoody's or an equivalent quality rating from another U.S. nationally recognized statistical ratings organization, or are deemed by the Sub-Fundto be of comparable quality. While the Sub-Fund may purchase securities of any maturity, under normal circumstances, its U.S. dollar-weightedaverage effective maturity is expected to be three years or less. The Sub-Fund may also use futures, forward contracts, options or swap agreements, as well as other derivatives, for hedging, efficient portfoliomanagement or investment purposes.

Investment goal

income and capital appreciation by investing, under normal market conditions, at least two-thirds of its total assets in corporate debt securitiesthat are below-investment-grade (i.e., rated lower than Baa by Moody's or lower than BBB by Standard & Poor's or, if unrated, determined to beof comparable quality by the Sub-Fund), at least 75% of its total assets in debt securities of U.S. issuers, up to 25% of its total assets in U.S.dollar-denominated debt securities of non-U.S. issuers, and up to 20% of its total assets in asset-backed securities. U. S. debt securities: (1) issued by companies with their principal office in the United States or exercising a predominant part of their economic activities inthe United States, or (2) issued by U.S. governmental issuers.
