

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Investment strategy

Its investment objective is to achieve a return Annual, net of fees and charges over the recommended investment period that exceeds the performance of its benchmark index, the EURO STOXX Small Net Return index. The composition of the Fund's portfolio may differ significantly from that of the benchmark index. The Fund is actively managed and invests in equities (including preference shares) and convertible securities denominated in euros (financial products that can be converted into equities). The Fund selects companies that it considers to offer the best commercial prospects in their respective industrial sectors. PEA-eligible securities always account for at least 75% of net of the Fund's assets. The Fund will observe the following net asset exposure limits: 60% to 100% in equities from all geographical areas, all market capitalisations (including emerging countries) and all sectors. The Fund may be exposed to European Union equities with a market capitalisation of between EUR 200 million and EUR 10 billion at the time of purchase (minimum 60%). From 0% to 10% of net assets may be invested in sovereign, public and private debt instruments, in the eurozone, irrespective of rating as determined by the asset management company or a credit-rating agency, or the lack of a rating. From 0% to 100% exposure to currency risk.

Investment goal

The Fund's management objective is to increase the value of your investment by investing in equities with a market capitalisation of between EUR 200 million and EUR 10 billion at the time of purchase.
