## What is this product?

**Type:** Shares of Lyxor Newcits IRL PLC, a SICAV MA.

**Term:** The term of the Sub-Fund is unlimited. The Management Company may terminate the fund by liquidation or merger with another fund in accordance with legal requirements.

**Objectives:** The investment objective of the Sub-Fund is to be exposed to the Strategy during the life of the Sub-Fund. The Strategy is based on two components, being (i) a proprietary discretionary trading strategy which has been developed by the Sub-Investment Manager (the "Trading Strategy") and (ii) an allocation of any excess cash to liquid assets pursuant to a process defined and implemented solely by the Manager (the "Cash Allocation Process").

**Intended Retail Investor:** This product is intended for investors, with an average knowledge of and some experience of investing in funds, and who are prepared to take on a high level of risk to their original capital.

**Redemption and Dealing:** Shares may be sold (redeemed) as stated in the prospectus at the respective dealing price (net asset value). Further details are provided in the Lyxor Newcits IRL PLC prospectus.

**Distribution Policy:** As this is a distributing share class, investment income is distributed.

We have classified this product as 3 out of 7, which is medium-low risk class. This rates the potential losses from future performance at a medium-low level, and poor market conditions are unlikely impact our capacity to pay you.

## What happens if Amundi Asset Management is unable to pay out?

The assets and liabilities of the Sub-Fund are segregated from those of other sub-funds as well as from those of the Management Company, and there is no cross-liability among any of them. The Sub-Fund would not be liable if the Management Company or any delegated service provider were to fail or default.

## What are the costs?

The tables show the amounts that are taken from your investment to cover different types of costs. These amounts depend on how much you invest, and how long you hold the product. We have assumed:

- In the first year you would get back the amount that you invested (0 % annual return). For the other holding periods we have assumed the product performs as shown in the moderate scenario.
- EUR 10,000 is invested.
