Objective and Investment Policy

The AXA WORLD FUNDS II – Evolving Trends Equities (herein after "the Sub-Fund" or "the Feeder fund") is a feeder fund to the AXA WORLD FUNDS – Framlington Evolving Trends (herein after "the Master fund"). In this regard, the Sub-Fund permanently invests at least 85% of its assets in the Master fund. The Sub-Fund may in addition hold up to 15% of its assets in ancillary liquid assets.

Summary of the Investment Objective and the Investment Policy of the Master fund:

Investment Objective

The Master fund seeks to achieve long-term capital growth measured in USD by investing in equities issued by worldwide companies of all capitalisations.

Investment Policy

The Master fund is actively managed in order to capture opportunities in worldwide equity markets. Investment decisions of the Master fund are based on a combination of macroeconomic, sector and company specific analysis. The share selection process of the Master fund relies mainly on a rigorous analysis of the companies' business model, quality of management, growth prospects and overall risk return profile, driven by sector specialists. The Master fund invests in equities and equity-related instruments issued by international companies of all capitalisations. The Master fund may also invest up to 10% of its assets in convertible securities.

The Master fund applies AXA IM Environment, Social and Governance (ESG) Standards available on www.axa-im.com/en/responsibleinvesting

Within the limit of 200% of the Master fund's net assets, the investment strategy of the Master fund may be achieved by direct investments and/or through derivatives. Derivatives may also be used for hedging purposes.

Income

For Distribution share classes (Dis), the dividend is distributed.

Sub-Fund Currency

The reference currency of the Sub-Fund is USD.

Investment Horizon

This Sub-Fund may not be suitable for investors who plan to withdraw their contribution within 8 years.

Processing of subscription and redemption orders

The subscription, conversion or redemption orders must be received by the Registrar and Transfer Agent on any Valuation Day no later than 2 p.m. Luxembourg Time. Orders will be processed at the Net Asset Value applicable to such Valuation Day. The investor's attention is drawn to the existence of potential additional processing time due to the possible involvement of intermediaries such as Financial Advisers or distributors.

The Net Asset Value of this Sub-Fund is calculated on a daily basis.

Minimum initial investment: 2,000 euros or the equivalent in the relevant currency of the relevant Share class.

Minimum subsequent investment: 1,000 euros or the equivalent in the relevant currency of the relevant Share class.

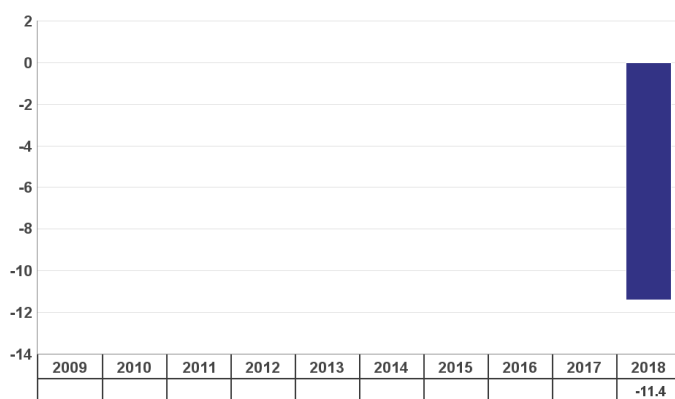
