### What is this product?

#### Type

The fund qualifies as a UCITS governed by Luxembourg law.

#### Term

This product does not have any minimum investment period, but the product is meant for medium to long-term investing and the minimum recommended investment period is 5 years. The minimum recommended investment period is based on the risk/return profile of the fund. If you dispose of the fund before the minimum recommended investment period, there will be a greater risk for the value fluctuation of the fund.

#### Objectives

The fund aims to make a return for you through a mixture of generating income and growing the amount you originally invested. It mainly invests in bonds issued by financial institutions that pay a fixed or variable interest.

The fund is actively managed and targets better returns than its benchmark, the JP Morgan Emerging Market Blend Hard Currency Credit 50-50 1-3 year Index, while taking into account Environmental, Social and Governance ("ESG") considerations. There are no restrictions on the extent to which the fund's portfolio and performance may deviate from the ones of the benchmark. As part of the investment process, the Investment Manager has full discretion over the composition of the fund's portfolio and may take exposure to companies, countries or sectors not included in the benchmark. At least two-thirds of the fund's investment will be in short duration fixed income bonds of any rating, or unrated, issued by entities based in emerging market countries. It is expected that the fund will target a weighted interest duration of 1 to 3 years. The fund will be actively exposed to hard currency (generally, globally-traded currencies from economically and politically stable countries) investments but not local currency (currencies of emerging market countries) investments.

In accordance with Article 8 of SFDR, the fund promotes environmental and social characteristics and investments which follow good governance practices. The environmental and social characteristics promoted by the fund consist in favouring investment in issuers whose business activities and/or conduct take an appropriate and responsible approach to ESG. Further information on the environment and social characteristics promoted by the fund is available in Appendix 2 of the prospectus.

The fund may use derivatives (such as futures, options and swaps, which are linked to the rise and fall of other assets) to obtain, increase or reduce exposure to underlying assets and may thus create gearing which may result in greater fluctuations of the value of the fund. The manager of the fund will ensure that the use of derivatives does not materially alter the overall risk profile of the fund.

The assets of the fund are held in safekeeping by its depositary, Brown Brothers Harriman (Luxembourg) S.C.A. (the "Depositary"). In the event of the insolvency of BlueBay Funds Management Company S.A., the fund's assets in the safekeeping of the Depositary will not be affected. However, in the event of the Depositary's insolvency, or someone acting on its behalf, the fund may suffer a financial loss. However, this risk is mitigated to a certain extent by the fact the Depositary is required by law and regulation to segregate its own assets from the assets of the fund. The Depositary will also be liable to the fund for any loss arising from, among other things, its negligence, fraud or intentional failure properly to fulfil its obligations (subject to certain limitations as set out in the agreement with the Depositary). Investors in the fund are not covered by any compensation scheme and could, in the worst case, lose their entire investment.
