## What is this product?

### Type

The Fund is a sub-fund of an undertaking for collective investment in transferable securities ("UCITS") under European Directive 2009/65/EC. An investment company with variable capital (société d'investissement à capital variable or "SICAV") under Luxembourg law.

### Term

There is no fixed maturity date. An investor can hold their investment for any time period but 5 year(s) is recommended. The Manufacturer can close the fund with notice.

### Objective and Investment Policy

The Portfolio aims to provide income combined with capital growth over the long term (at least 5 years). The Portfolio is actively managed and combines a core equity component with an active derivatives strategy to enhance income. The Investment Manager believes that an appropriate comparator benchmark for reviewing fund performance is the MSCI All Country World NR Index (the "Index"), given the investment policy of the Portfolio and the approach taken by the Investment Manager. The Portfolio is not constrained by this benchmark and has significant freedom to invest in a portfolio that is materially different to the benchmark's own composition. The Portfolio will invest more than 50% of its net assets in equity securities in the sense of sec. 2 para. 8 of the GITA. The Portfolio aims to provide long-term capital growth by investing primarily in sustainable investments, considered for this Portfolio to be shares of companies that derive, or are on a credible short to medium-term pathway to derive, a significant amount of net revenue (50% or more) from activities that can be directly linked to one or more of the UN Sustainable Development Goals ("SDGs"). The Portfolio invests in shares of companies which may be located anywhere in the world, be of any size and from any industry or economic sector, subject to the Investment Manager's sustainable investment criteria.

Income from investments in the Fund will be added to the value of your shares.

You can buy or sell shares in the Fund on any day which is a business day in Luxembourg unless the directors have decided that insufficient markets are open. ### Intended retail investor

This fund is aimed at Retail and Professional customers and Eligible Counterparties who should have at least a basic level of knowledge and experience of investing in funds. It is designed for investors looking for income who can invest their money for at least 5 years. Your capital is not guaranteed which means that investors could lose up to 100% of the amount invested. The fund invests directly and through derivatives in shares of small and mid-capitalisation companies, the prices of which tend to fluctuate more than other asset classes, as investors directly participate in underlying companies and their profits and losses.
