Objectives and investment policy

The fund is actively managed. The fund is managed in reference to a benchmark. The objective of the investment policy is to achieve sustained capital appreciation that exceeds the benchmark (ML Euro BB-B Non-Financial Fixed & FRN High Yield Constrained). In order to achieve this, the fund invests globally in corporate bonds. The focus here is on high-yield bonds. When selecting investments, environmental and social aspects and the principles of good corporate governance (ESG aspects) are taken into consideration alongside the financial performance. The selection of individual investments is at the discretion of the fund management. The majority of the fund's securities or their issuers are expected to be components of the benchmark. The fund management will use its discretion to invest in e.g. securities, sectors, ratings that are not included in the benchmark in order to take advantage of specific investment opportunities. The portfolio is not necessarily expected to have a similar weighting to the benchmark. In regard to its


