## **Objectives and investment policy**

#### Objectives

To provide long-term capital growth on your investment by investing in shares of companies located in the Balkan region.

#### Investment policy

At least 75% of the sub-fund's assets shall consist of shares and equity related instruments.

The sub-fund will invest at least 50% of its assets in companies located in Albania, Austria, Bosnia-Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Cyprus, Greece, Croatia, Hungary, Macedonia, Montenegro, Romania, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia, the Czech Republic and Turkey.

The sub-fund may also invest in companies not located in the aforementioned countries but which exercise a significant part of their economic activity there.

The sub-fund is actively managed and it has a significant degree of deviation

from the reference index, STOXX Balkan Total Market Index.

The reference currency of the sub-fund is expressed in EUR. The currency of the share class is expressed in SEK.

The investor may subscribe and redeem shares on each bank business day in Luxembourg.



## **Risk and reward profile**



The sub-fund is a high-risk fund that invests in emerging markets, which means that fluctuations in price are common. This is because investments on the Balkan stock markets are more likely to experience sharp rises and falls in value.
