Lazard Nordic High Yield Bond Fund is a sub-fund of Lazard Global Investment Funds Public Limited Company (the "UCITS")

Objectives and Investment Policy

Lazard Nordic High Yield Bond Fund (the "Fund") aims to maximise total return from income and capital growth.

The Fund is actively managed and may invest in a diversified portfolio of high yielding (including non-investment grade and unrated) fixed and floating rate debt securities (e.g. bonds) issued or guaranteed by corporates, sovereigns, governments and quasi-governmental bodies in Scandinavian countries (i.e. Denmark, Finland, Iceland, Norway and Sweden) in local Scandinavian currencies, or in hard currencies (i.e. currencies of the G7 nations).

Securities will have an individual credit rating, or deemed rating by the Investment Manager, at the time of purchase of B3/B- or higher. Where securities are downgraded or are no longer deemed equivalent to B3/B- at a later date, the Investment Manager may at its sole discretion continue to hold the downgraded securities.

The Fund may also invest in debt securities issued or guaranteed by any other corporates, sovereigns, governments and quasi-governmental bodies provided the security is issued or denominated in the local Scandinavian currency.

The individual selection of the securities will be determined by the Investment Manager's assessment of credit quality of the issuers (i.e. the capacity of issuers to meet their obligations); nature and maturity of the instruments; and the relative value offered compared to instruments from comparable issuers.

Up to 10% of the Fund's value may be held in cash and in investments that are deemed to be equivalent to cash. This percentage may be exceeded where deemed appropriate by the Investment Manager in light of market conditions.

The Fund may gain exposure to the asset classes above either by investing in them directly, or by using derivatives (which are financial contracts whose value is linked to the price of the underlying investment), for the purposes of efficient portfolio management. The currency exposures of the Fund's portfolio will be substantially hedged back into Euro, being the base currency of the Fund.

As a result of its use of derivatives, the Fund may be 'geared' or 'leveraged' (which can lead to a proportionately much larger movement in the value of the Fund's assets). The expected level of the Fund's leverage will be 100% of the value of the Fund.

You can buy and sell shares in the Fund on any day treated as a normal business day in Frankfurt, Denmark, Norway and Sweden.

The Fund has discretion as to which investments it will hold within the limits of the Investment Objective and Policy.

Income and profits, if any, attributable to your shares will not be paid out as a dividend but will be accumulated in the Fund on your behalf and reflected in an increase in the value of your holdings.

The Fund's performance is not measured in reference to a benchmark.

The Fund promotes environmental and/or social characteristics within the meaning of Article 8 of Regulation (EU) 2019/2088, the "SFDR Regulation".

Recommendation: This Fund may not be appropriate for investors who plan to withdraw their money within a short period of time.

Risk and Reward Profile



The risk and reward categories above are calculated using historic data and may not be a reliable indicator of the Fund's future risk profile. The risk and reward category may shift over time and is not a target or guarantee.

The lowest category (i.e. category 1) does not mean "risk free".

The risk rating of this share class is calculated on the basis of historic volatility – i.e. how much the value of the underlying assets of the Fund has fluctuated over the last 5 years. As this share class does not have 5 years' performance data available, we have simulated the volatility, using a suitable proxy, based on historic data.

This share class has been placed in the risk category stated above, because based on the simulated historic data, the underlying assets within the Fund have shown moderate volatility.

Please note, there are other risks that may not be reflected in the risk and reward categories above. Some of these risks are summarised below.

- There is no capital guarantee or protection of the value of the Fund. The value of your investment and the income from it can go down as well as up and you may not get back the amount you originally invested.

- Investment in lower rated bonds increases the risk of default on repayment and the risk to capital of the Fund.
- The Fund may hold a significant amount of its value in deposits and/or money market instruments, but should not be considered by investors as an alternative to investing in a regular deposit account. Investors should note that a holding in the Fund is subject to the risks associated with investing in a collective investment undertaking, in particular fluctuations in value.
- There is a risk that the other side to certain contracts that the Fund may enter into may not be able to meet obligations. For example, this may arise in the Fund where an investment is made using a derivative or a debt instrument, and the other side to the agreement becomes insolvent, or is otherwise unable to meet its obligations. In such a case, the Fund may incur loss.
- There are additional risks relating to the use of derivatives - the Fund invests in derivatives for the purposes of both reducing exposure (hedging) and also to gain greater exposure to underlying investments. The use of derivatives can increase the possibility for profit but also increase the risk of loss.
- The Fund may invest in units or shares of other investment funds. Such other funds may themselves be subject to their own fees and expenses.
- In view of the concentrated nature of the Fund's investments, the level of risk is expected to be higher than for a broader based portfolio and the value may be more volatile.
- The returns from your investment may be affected by changes in the exchange rate between the Fund's base currency, the currency of the Fund's investments, your share class and your home currency.

Charges

The charges you pay are used to pay the costs of running the Fund, including marketing and distributing costs. These charges reduce the potential growth of your investment.
