### Objectives & Investment Policy

The aim is for your investment to reflect the performance of the IBOXX € GERMANY® index.

The Index reflects certain types of tradeable debt (bonds) denominated in Euro or pre-Euro currencies issued by the German government. The composition of the Index is rebalanced according to a pre-set methodology.

For bonds to be included in the Index on a monthly rebalancing date, they must, on the relevant rebalancing date, have a remaining time to maturity of at least one year. The Index is calculated on a total return basis which means that amounts

equivalent to interest payments on the bond are reinvested in the Index. The Index is sponsored by International Index Company Limited and reviewed and rebalanced monthly.

To achieve the aim, the Fund will buy bonds and/or invest in cash deposits and enter into financial contract(s) (derivative(s)) with Deutsche Bank relating to the bonds/deposits and the Index, in order to obtain the return on the Index.

Dividends may be paid on your shares the amount of which will be equal to 4% of the value of your shares.

You may redeem your investment on demand on a daily basis.

### Risk and Reward Profile



The risk and reward category is calculated using historical data which may not be a reliable indicator of the Fund's future risk profile.

The lowest category (i.e. Category 1) does not mean a risk-free investment.

The Fund is in Category 3 because of the low range and frequency of price movements (volatility) of the underlying investments referenced by the Fund.

The Fund will enter into a derivative with a counterparty (initially Deutsche Bank). If the counterparty fails to make payments (for example, it becomes insolvent) this may result in your investments suffering a loss.

Deutsche Bank and its related companies may act in several roles in relation to the Fund such as promoter, distributor, derivative counterparty and management company which may involve conflicts of interest.

The Fund may invest in bonds the value of which depends on the issuer being able to make its payments. There is always a risk

that the issuer will fail to do so which may result in your investment suffering a loss.

The Fund is not guaranteed and your investment is at risk. The value of your investment may go down as well as up.

Fluctuations in interest rates of the currency of the shares, the Index or the other assets of the Fund may affect the value of your investment.
